Daniel P. Parent, 78, of Easthampton, passed away peacefully on Tuesday April 28, 2026, at the Cooley Dickinson Hospital surrounded by his loving family. Danny was born in Springfield, MA on October 10, 1947, to the late Paul Parent and Helen (Fairbanks) Sadlowski.
