Edward H. Dunny, 93, of Northampton, passed away peacefully at the Holyoke Soldiers Home on July 10, 2024, after a long period of declining health from Alzheimer's. He was born in Northampton on September 2, 1930, to the late George and Sophie (Watras) Dunny.

He served in the US Army in the Korean War and was honorably discharged in May of 1960.
