Robert Patrick, 78, of Moultonborough, NH, passed away on Wednesday April 22, 2026, at Concord Hospital in Concord, NH after a brief illness. He was born in Northampton on June 16, 1948, to the late Anthony and Anna (Ferry) Patrick.
